The theme for the worship this year is the Christian Calendar when we will celebrate the key Christian dates as they occur and look at other relevant areas in between. This week we continue to look at Pentecost and in particular the commission to spread the good news of the Gospel.

In our worship we will look at the Great Commission, when Jesus encouraged His disciples to go and tell all people the Good News of the Gospel. It is a reminder that the message of God's sacrificial love is for all people – it is inclusive rather than exclusive. It is interesting that for the Church of England the first role of Church schools is mission –to share the Gospel message and I am pleased that we are able to do that within our community.

It is important to remember that Jesus said that people would know that we are His disciples by the love we show for one another and I hope that in all our interactions as a school community we do witness to that love in action.

We will be talking to the children about how they share good news in general, but also as a Christian community how do we show God's love and share the Good News of the Gospel.
